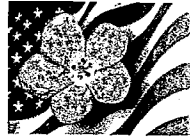
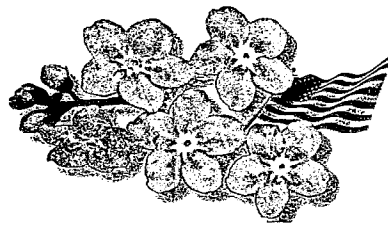

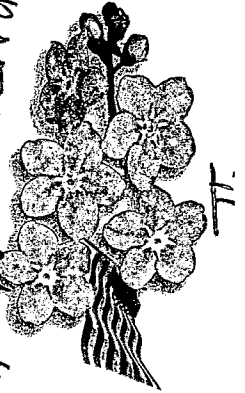
Mr. Morin:

We were very impressed with Dan, the on site-supervisor. He told us he would be here every-

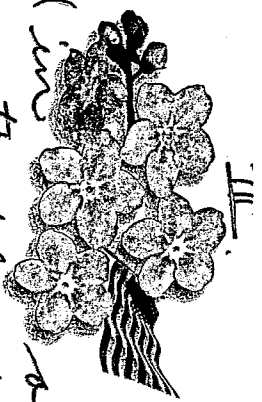
